The Ollie Feast Trust Travel Bursaries

The Ollie Feast Trust is a charity that was established in 2015 following the accidental death of Ollie Feast. In recognition of Ollie's love and experience of life across the world, the Trust supports young people's personal development through travel. Particularly those who would not otherwise be likely to afford to travel in pursuit of their own development.

The Trust will consider applications for travel bursaries up to a maximum of £500 a year. It is normally expected that bursaries will be awarded to Year 11 and 6th Formers but others around this age group may apply, with each application being judged on its merits. The travel must be planned within one year of the application date.

Travel bursaries will be awarded by the Trustees to those who make a strong case to pursue a personal development and travel project within the UK or other countries. This could be as an individual; or as part of a group. Proposed activities do not have to be linked to public service or charitable activities but must be for a worthwhile reason. Applicants may wish to note that Ollie thrived on the pleasure, joy and stimulation that travel and exploration provides. The bursaries are to enable others to gain and benefit from similar experience.

We would be willing to look at any application on its merits. These could range from the personal, such as an arts student wanting to look at a collection in the UK or abroad or a more organised project e.g. www.sportingopportunities.com, or in support of Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme etc.

Applications should follow the outline as set out below:

1. Name and date of birth
2. Home address and email address
3. Present School
4. Details of the travel plan
 - a. How the trip will support personal and/or wider development
 - b. Destination of the trip
 - c. Reasons for choosing this destination
 - d. Timing and duration of the trip
 - e. Organisation involved (if there is one)
 - f. Reasons for choice of this organisation
 - g. If the travel is part of an organized school activity

5. Finance

- a. Financial need – we will prioritise those who have already tried to raise money by their own efforts
- b. Cost of project
- c. Proposed means of raising additional monies if required

6. Significant academic or extracurricular achievements

- a. At school
- b. Outside school
- c. Any additional information

The application should be accompanied by a written reference, preferably from a senior teacher, or another responsible adult.

You should be prepared to present a written or oral report upon completion of your travels to the Ollie Feast Trust committee. Recipients of Ollie Feast bursaries will be encouraged to support the Trust in future years, so that more people can continue to be helped.

If for whatever reason a trip fails to take place, the Trust require the bursary be refunded to the charity.

Applications will be acknowledged on receipt and can be made at any time of the year. Successful applicants will be contacted by one of the Trustees. Information regarding the Trust can be found at www.theOllieFeastTrust.com.
